# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



My fellow IITK alum,

It's been an exciting four years for the IITK Foundation team and we continue to grow our outreach, fundraising, and operational activities with each passing year. I am proud to present our Fourth Annual Report with detailed insights on our organization, activities, accomplishments, and finances.

To begin with some organizational updates:

Our CFO, Vinod Baya, handed over the baton to Vipin Agarwal (B.Tech/CHE/2003) who is now deputed as the new CFO. Vinod has played an instrumental role in shaping the Foundation finances, accounting, and processes as the new team took over the reins 4 years ago and I cannot thank him enough for his contributions to the Foundation. We bid farewell to Prof. Kantesh Balani and Prof. S. Ganesh who were serving as ex-officio members to IITK Foundation Board and welcome Prof. Amey Karkare (Dean, Resources & Alumni) and Prof. Manindra Agrawal (Director IITK) to the Board. The other Board members continue their journey with Divya Yerraguntla as VP Marketing, Jai Rawat as VP Faculty Alumni Initiatives and Ratan Bajpai as the Secretary for the Foundation as well as leader of the chapter expansion initiative.

Through our collective volunteering effort and with the strong support from the IITK Development Foundation team led by Kapil Kaul at Kanpur we continue to achieve several milestones and streamline our operational processes. To name a few:

- Engaged around 800+ alumni through our yearly IIT Karvaan roadshow across multiple cities in US: New York, New Jersey, Washington DC, Chicago, Seattle, and San Francisco
- Hired a dedicated accounting team to handle our book-keeping and to streamline our donation tracking as well as the donor stewardship process. This has increased efficiency and reduced turnaround time for donor acknowledgement, receipt generation, etc.
- The Foundation Appreciation Award is presented to alumni in North America who demonstrate exceptional dedication to fostering a vibrant and connected alumni community. This year, the Foundation was proud to honor Shloke Hajela, Jitesh Jain, and Namita Maunder with this award for their outstanding contributions towards alumni community
- The first ever North American Distinguished Alumni Meet was held in New York on 5th October 2024. This engaging full day event spearheaded by IITK Foundation, saw participation from 24 eminent awardees who provided valuable feedback on the IIT Kanpur director Prof. Manindra Agrawal's vision for the campus
- Multiple fundraising campaigns focused on the development of IITK and welfare of society at large. Few of the major campaigns of 2023 and 2024 were (Lalit Beniwal Memorial Fund - 250 donors, Season of Giving - 300+ donors, Various Batch Funds, Memorial Funds, etc.)
- Last but not the least, I am happy to report on the fundraising front that the team has helped raise approximately **USD 8.5 million** for calendar year 2023 and **USD 7 million** for year 2024 (till Sept-2024). I am very grateful to the generosity of the donors across the continent and would like to express my deepest thanks to my team at IITK Foundation and my extended team at IITK Development Foundation (IITK DF) in India
- I would like to add a note around our operations. I am proud to share that as a volunteer only organization, we have been operating the Foundation with remarkable efficiency. Over the last 4 years of the operation, our operational overhead has been less than **0.65%**. For reference, the normal overhead at non-profit organizations range from 10-15% and even 20-25% overhead numbers are not unheard of. As we scale our operations, our overhead is likely to increase, but we will strive to keep it well below industry norm

Like each year we continued our tradition of hosting IIT Karvaan across the U.S. with the objective of creating massive alumni outreach, enhancing brand visibility, building university and corporate partnerships, and to support faculty recruitment. A special highlight of this year's Karvaan was the first ever design and launch of high-quality IITK Branded T Shirts across various North America locations. The logistics and management of the whole process was ensured by our dedicated volunteers of the Foundation. This year the Karvaan began in New York with a highly successful Distinguished Alumni Meet (DAM) at the office of IBM in Manhattan New York and a larger alumni networking event hosted in New Jersey thereafter.

Prof. Manindra Agrawal, the new Director at IIT Kanpur, has embarked on an inspiring vision for the transformation of IITK into a global institute of excellence. His focus now is on 'Translational Research', which promises to transform IITK's impact as a leader in bridging research with real-world applications. It is a shift that promises to significantly enhance the institute's reputation and open new funding opportunities. Recognizing Uttar Pradesh's growth momentum, he highlighted IITK's unique role in driving this progress through technological innovations. Prof. Agrawal also emphasized on the importance of renewing teaching excellence through a dedicated Center for Teaching Excellence and by establishing diverse career tracks in traditional R&D, translational research, and teaching. His vision paints a compelling path forward, setting a powerful trajectory for our alma mater.

The Karvaan then headed towards Washington DC and Chicago. The bandwagon moved towards a new stop this year in Seattle where we hosted the event at the Tech Mahindra office in Redmond. The final stop was our famous Computer History Museum in San Francisco Bay Area. This year's engagements were exceptionally enriching, with a growing number of alumni registering and participating enthusiastically in each event. We hope that these events will act as a catalyst for creating new and sustainable IITKAA chapters across the country. IIT Karvaan always provides an excellent opportunity for numerous accomplished IITK alums to engage, network and discuss possibilities of establishing a formal framework of collaboration between IITK faculty and veteran subject matter experts in the IITK alumni community. With your invaluable support, the Foundation has instituted a total of 37 programs at IIT Kanpur between January 2023 to September 2024. This includes 12 new Scholarships, 11 Awards, 3 Distinguished Lecture Series, 2 Travel Grants, 2 Faculty Fellowships, 1 Special Program and 6 Faculty Chairs. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all our donors. We are deeply committed to providing our donors with timely and detailed updates on the impact of their contributions. By sharing clear, comprehensive reports on fund allocation, utilization, and financial progress, we ensure that donors see the real-world impact of their support. This transparency strengthens our accountability and reinforces the powerful relationship between our donors and the ongoing advancement of our shared goal for IIT Kanpur. Our yearly financial information is available at the Foundation website <https://iitkfoundation.org>. Like previous year, we have initiated a complete financial audit with an external firm to ensure that we follow all necessary processes and that our financial operations are in compliance with the Internal Revenue Service.

I recently had the privilege of visiting the IITK campus during the 65th Institute Foundation Day celebration on Nov 2nd wherein I was honored to receive the Distinguished Services Award 2024 from our alma mater. During the visit, I saw firsthand the transformative impact of our donor funded projects on campus. I visited the Maker's Space project supported by the Class of 1991, the upgraded and expanded Gym donated by the Class of 1970, The Shivani Centre for Nurture and Reintegration of Hindi and Other Indian Languages, and The Gangwal School of Medical Sciences and Technology and the Yadupati Singhanian Super Specialty Hospital generously supported by our esteemed donors. It was truly gratifying to witness these projects' progress, and I look forward with excitement to seeing how these initiatives evolve as they reach new milestones and continue enriching the IITK community and the society at large.

I must acknowledge the existing chapter leaders across the country who played an instrumental role in making the IIT Karvaan successful – Jitesh Jain, Shloke Hajela, Namita Maunder, Dhruv Singh, Swati Saxena, Sameer Behere, Amit Bhatia from Silicon Valley; Nitin Maheshwari, Ratnesh Kumar, Sukhwant Khanuja, and Somnath Ghosh from Chicago; Kunal Kishore, Yogesh Mittal, Dhires Kumar, Salil Dave, Raj Sehgal, Mukul Kumar, Arun Kumar, Nikhil Aggarwal, Ajit Kumar, and Rajat Nigam from Seattle; Adesh Jain, Atul Mathur, and Rajit from Washington DC; Saurabh Srivastava, Kapil Varshney, and Ratan Bajpai from New York. Our quest to develop strong IITK local chapters across the country continues. These chapters are essential in engaging our local alumni communities, fostering connections, and strengthening our shared bond with IIT Kanpur.

I also welcome suggestions from our wider alumni community on ways the Foundation can enhance alumni engagement and strengthen IIT Kanpur's future. 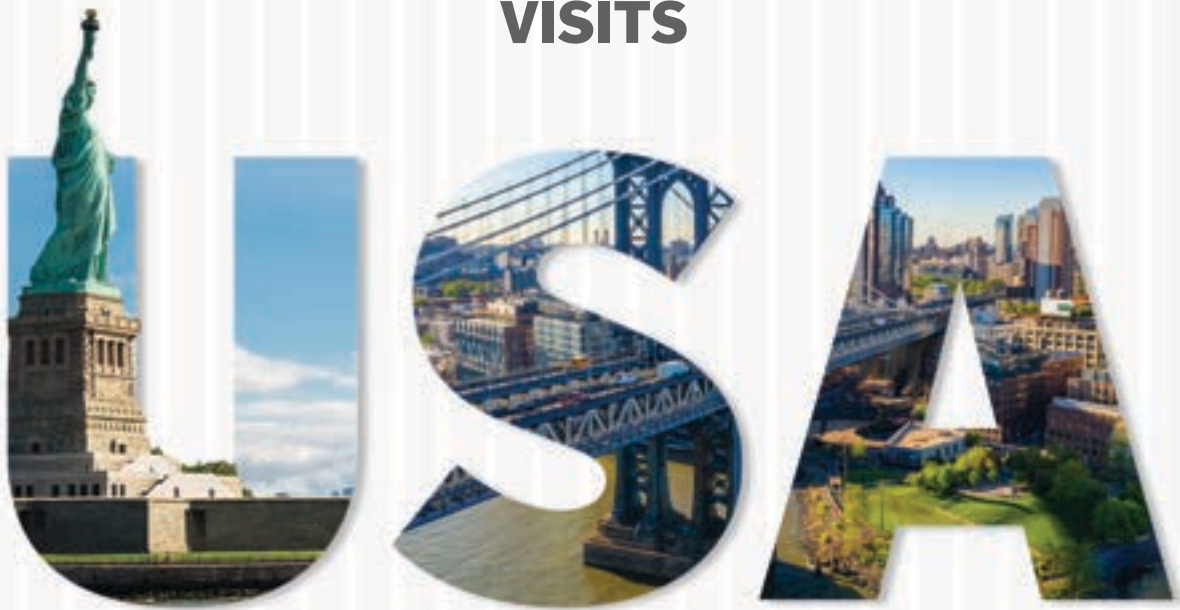

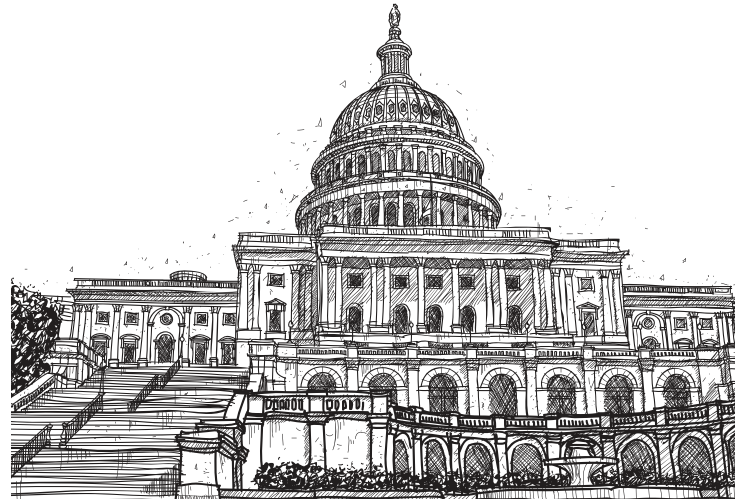

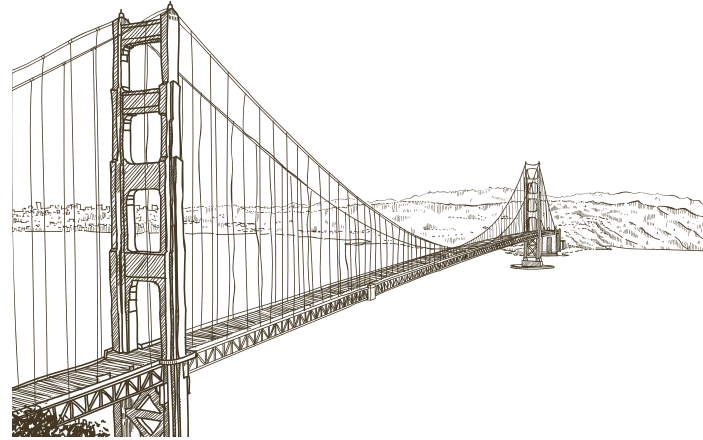

I graduated with B.Tech in EE in 1976, and then M.Tech in EE in 1979. The education was excellent, with a very accomplished faculty and bright classmates. Above all, IIT taught me how to thrive in a male world. I also have very warm memories of so many fun times spent with friends, especially in the Girls' Hostel.

IIT opened the doors of the world to me. After IIT, I pursued higher education at Carnegie-Mellon University in USA, and worked at Philips Research. I have had a rewarding career as an engineer and researcher that has brought a sense of accomplishment. I am proud to have graduated from IIT Kanpur. Even after all these years, I can impress people just by telling them that I graduated from IITK.

For the past many years, I, along with my husband, have been making annual contributions to the IITK Foundation as part of its annual giving program. We feel it is important to give back to an institution that has given me so much, and to which I am still deeply attached. Our donations allow IITK to keep investing in facilities and students, and to reach new heights. As an alumna, I feel invested in IIT's future. 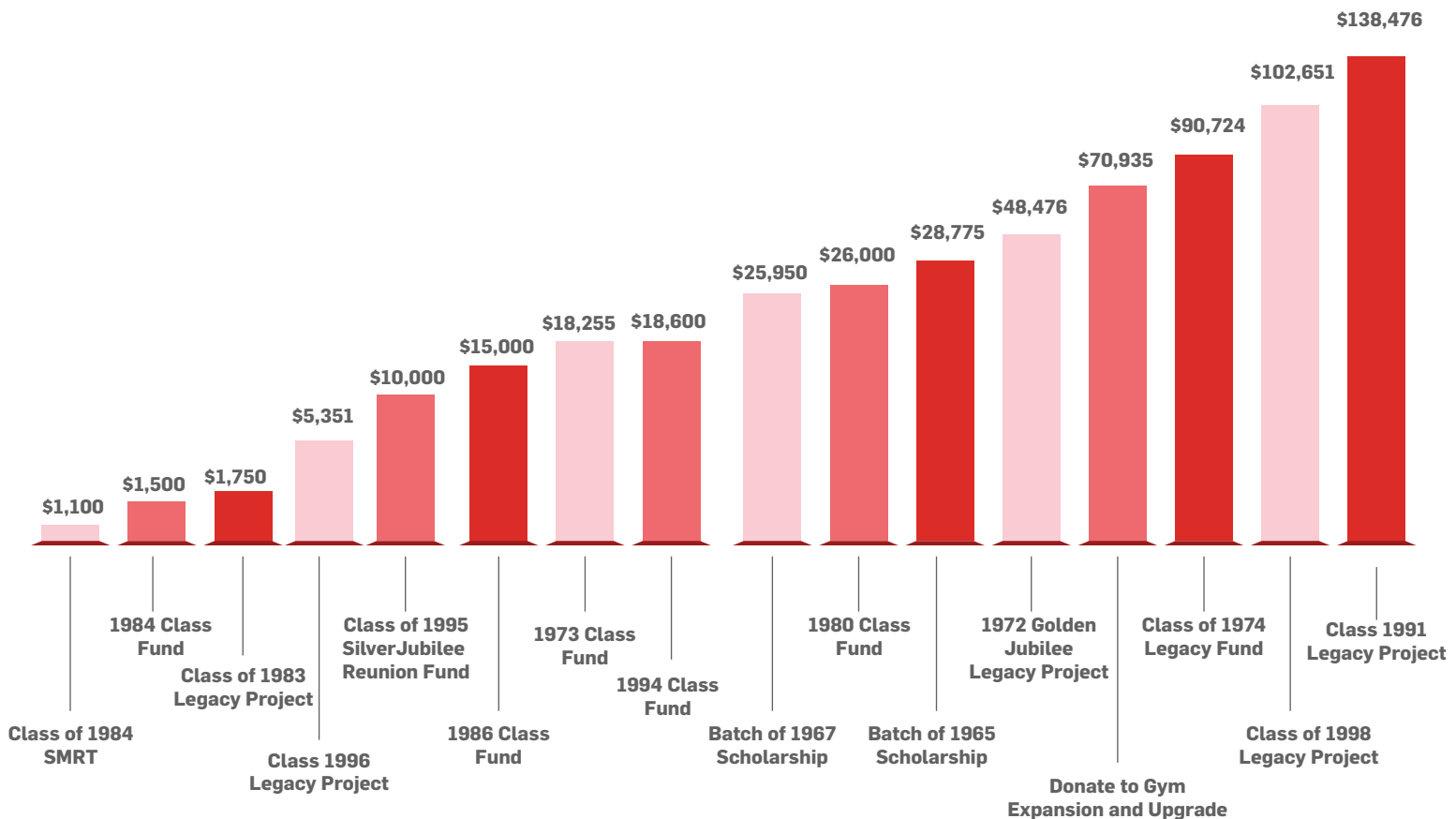
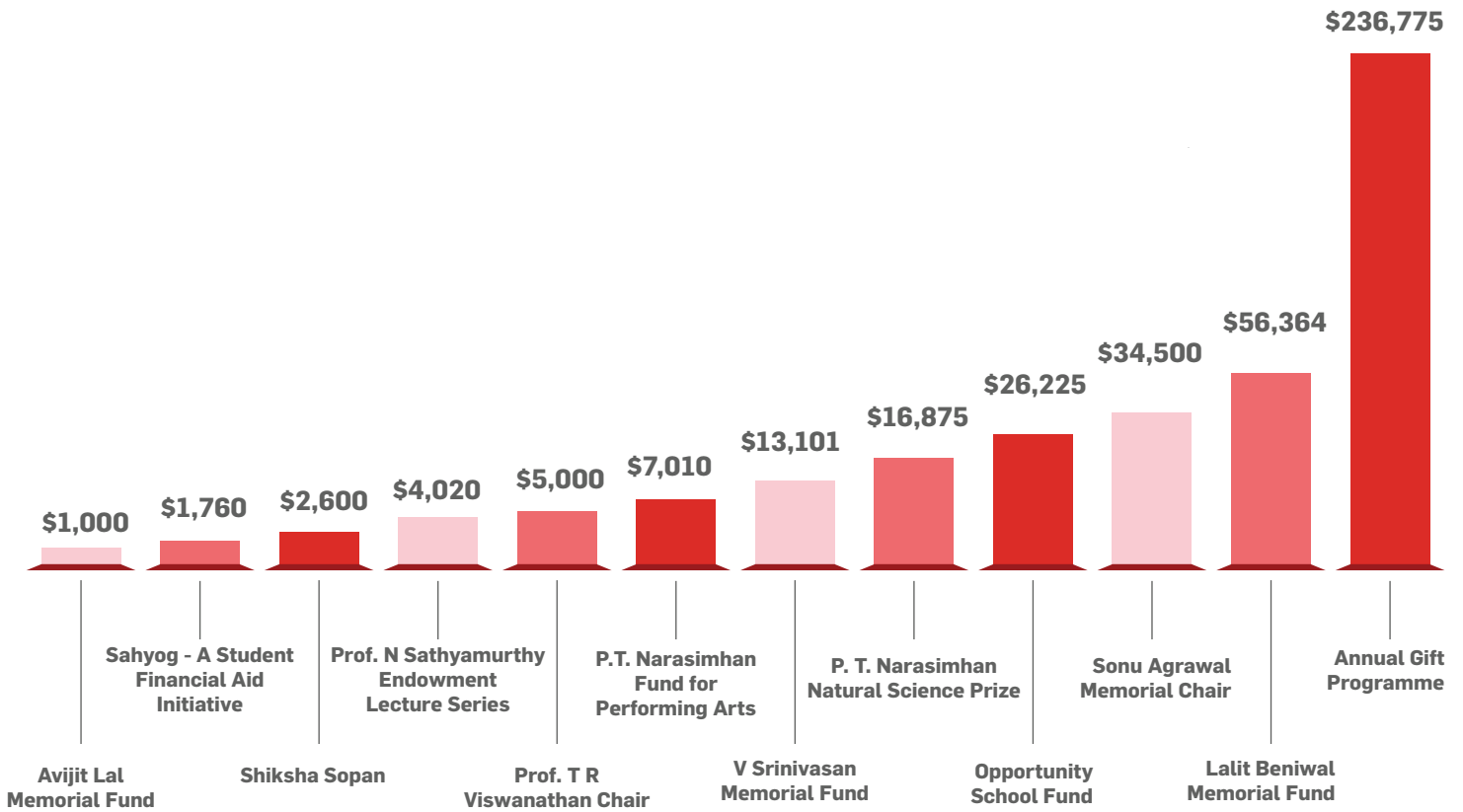
